Summary: Volunteering themselves, assisting parents/volunteers with, and delegating out picture taking and filming responsibilities

Responsibilities:

- Ensuring filming and photography is delegated out for each team
- Helping to ensure camera's/camcorders are available for each team
- Assisting parents/volunteers attempting to use the drop box tab on the booster club website page to upload pictures
- Selecting the best pictures to be given to the website/social media chair to be uploaded to the website
- Delegating highlight video making to whichever player is making the highlight videos that year for that team
- (Potentially) make and add a CGUC watermark to the best pictures to help build brand recognition
- Help supply pictures previously taken, to various committees as needed
- Communicate with, organize, and have paid for, LiveStreamMedia to come film at in state events
- Work with our own tournament Director, or our head coach, to schedule what games will be filmed

Goal: Ensure media coverage for each team through photography and film

Suggested Path of Communication: Report to Board with occasional progress. If you have radical ideas or want to make major changes request approval from the Board. For minor details and day to day things, feel free to work in a fashion that suits you best but ensures the goal is met in a quality way. Recruit other parents to work with or delegate things to as you see fit, depending on the size of various tasks and your ability to complete them with/without aid. Remember that, while you are free to create your own committee to help you, the chair is solely responsible for ensuring the goal is reached and for making the committee successful.
